

Holding the Rapidan

Thursday, September 29th through Sunday, October 1st

- The Military Schedule is for reenactors, primarily for Officers and NCOs. The schedule contains the required/requested elements from both Brigade Commands. It is typical of a standard reenactment with the following exceptions:
- Friday night there is a “mandatory” meeting of Officers and First Sergeants in the 15th MVI Camp. Refreshments provided.
- There is a voluntary participation skirmish on Saturday with mandatory safety and tactical briefing for participating Officers and NCOs. *Given the current registration, this is currently unlikely to occur.*
- There is an artillery night fire open to the public on Saturday Evening that should last 30-45 minutes.
- Although everyone is always welcome to join the 15th MVI for singing and fellowship on Saturday night at this event we will have hot cider and cider donuts for those who make the trek to the union camp. Bring your own chair.
- There is NO company or Battalion Drill on Sunday. The time is reserved for the Annual Reenactor Hall of Fame presentations. It is the last event of the year. If the troops can't march and maneuver by the last Sunday of the season, we can transfer them to the Invalid Corps.
