The Forecast for Mason New Hampshire as of 9.26.22

- Thursday, Sept 29: High 61, Low 40. Scattered clouds during the day to mostly clear skies at night. 59%-75% Humidity. Winds NNW 5-10 mph. Chance of Rain 5%
- Friday, Sept 30: High 64, Low 44. Mostly sunny during the day to Partly Cloudy skies at night. 54%-79% Humidity. Winds NW 3 mph. Chance of Rain 4%
